## Breakout Session Descriptions

<b>Sessions that focus on children of all ages</b>
<b>Mom &amp; Dad: Working as a Team</b> –Learn about what the Bible has to say about unity in marriage, and the effects that this has on children. You’ll be provided with practical ways to work as a team.
<b>Homes Affected by Hurts, Habits, and Hang-ups</b> – Hurts, habits, and hang-ups include a broad range of struggles, such as all types of addictions, anger, depression or other mental health diagnoses, infidelity, codependency, homosexuality, anxiety, and much more. If someone in your family, parent or child, struggles with any of these issues, join us for support, resources, and to gain new insights on how to work through these issues.
<b>Raising Children in Modern Culture</b> –Learn about the Biblical response to some commonly used practices and approaches in education, instruction, and treatment, as it relates to parenting. Facilitated by a clinician and a public educator; valuable insights will be presented on their observations of some trends and how to approach them Biblically.
<b>Sessions that focus on late elementary age to teens</b>
<b>Preparing Boys for Every Man's Battle</b> - Learn how to talk to boys about life's most difficult issues and in the process create a relationship where they will always desire your input in their lives. This workshop is targeted at men raising boys primarily in the age range of 7 - 14 years.
<b>Preparing Girls for Every Woman's Battle</b> – This session provides suggestions and useful tips on how to clearly communicate Biblical principles to young girls about purity, relationships, marriage, honor, gender identity, and womanhood.
<b>Firewalls: Protecting Your Home</b> —Learn about safety strategies for protecting your children from internet abusers, predators, etc.
<b>Tough Love Parenting: Tips for Parenting Rebellious Teenagers--</b> Tough Love is exactly that – tough, not just for the kids, but for the parents as well! Loving our children is unconditional, but we don't have to like what they are doing or how they may be destroying their lives. Come be encouraged and hear a few tips on when and how to use tough love.
<b>Sessions that focus on elementary age children (approx 5yr-11yr)</b>
<b>Developing Spiritual Champions</b> – This session focuses on how to plant a deeply-rooted foundation of faith in your child at an early age.
<b>Innovative Parenting</b> – Using Biblical principles, this session provides some creative ways to teach, train, discipline, correct, and guide your child in day-to-day life.
<b>Sessions that focus on toddlers-preK (approx 2yr-4yr)</b>
<b>Loving Discipline, Correction Tools, &amp; Child Training</b> – Learn about practical ways to implement Biblical discipline with your child, including appropriate uses for the “rod.” This session also focuses on implementing practices and routines beneficial for your household and family.
