



#13 Brutal (άνήμερος) – One who is opposite of gentle and tame...they will be fierce and hate what is good and godly. 1 Timothy 3:3e (NIV)

#14 Not lovers of the good (ἀφιλάγαθος) – One who is an enemy to what is good... they find greater kinship with a corrupt world. 1 Timothy 3:3f (NIV)

#15 Treacherous (προδότης) – One who betrays the well-being of another... they turn away from a friend instead of being an advocate. 1 Timothy 3:4a (NIV)

#16 Rash (προπετής) – One who rushes headlong into trouble... they are headstrong, easily provoked, and harm others without thinking. 1 Timothy 3:4b (NIV)

#17 Conceited (τυφόμεναι) – One who swells or inflates with pride... they tower over everyone with their views. 1 Timothy 3:4c (NIV)

#18 Lovers of pleasure (φιλήδονος) – One who adopts a hedonistic lifestyle... they pursue sensual lust and drag others into evil. 1 Timothy 3:4d (NIV)

#19 Having a form of godliness (μόρφωσις) – One with a false outward appearance of living for God... they go through the motions of Christianity without the transforming power of obedience in following God alone. 1 Timothy 3:5a (NIV)

#2 Lovers of money (φιλάργυρος) – One who seeks wealth and possessions as a means of power, control, and security... they are driven by greed. **1 Timothy 3:2b (NIV)**

#3 Boastful (άλαζών) – One who is given to bragging about accomplishments... they are deaf to others. **1 Timothy 3:2c (NIV)**

#4 Proud (υπερήφανος) – One who has sinful thoughts of the heart continuously... they reject anything having to do with God and His church. **1 Timothy 3:2d (NIV)**

#5 Abusive (βλάσφημος) – Those who disregard and disrespect others... they belittle others they deem inferior. **1 Timothy 3:2e (NIV)**

#6 Disobedient to their parents (γονεύς) – Adults who reject the counsel of their parents... they have issues with any authority. **1 Timothy 3:2f (NIV)**

#7 Ungrateful (άχάριστος) – Those with a complete lack of thankfulness... they walk around with a spirit of entitlement. **1 Timothy 3:2g (NIV)**

#8 Unholy (άνόσιος) – Those with a mindset to reject God's moral laws... they are devoted to what is godless. **1 Timothy 3:2h (NIV)**

#9 Without love (άστοργος) – One who is hardhearted... they offer nothing to others without expecting something in return. **1 Timothy 3:3a (NIV)**

#10 Unforgiving (άσπονδος) – One who remains at odds with everyone... they cannot admit wrongdoing and refuse to forgive offenses. **1 Timothy 3:3b (NIV)**
